



Amplifiers fixes better 3G coverage inside

This easy to install 3g amplifier promises better signal to the cell phone and modem in the basement or small office.



With the new 3G-amplifier to improve the reception in a snap, provided you have permission for it.

Zboost One vx-400u is the name of a so-called repeater station from Wi-Ex that enhances 3G coverage in places where the signal is usually very poor. The device is intended for indoor use and is said except in the cottage or basement room also fit well in the small office.

The amplifier is placed in a window facing the operator's nearest base station and synchronize the correct operator by pressing a button, while making a call.

In order to use the device requires, however, two permits. First, one from the operator, and one from the Post and Telecom Agency. The amplifier works with all Swedish operators except Net1 and signal to cover the surfaces of "up to a few rooms," according to the Swedish retailer Induo.

The obvious limitations is that the device only manages an operator at a time, and up to four users simultaneously. The price is approximately SEK 2,000 excluding VAT.
